





- 2. Secrecy Test— "Would it bother me if everyone knew this was my choice?" (Proverbs 11:3)
- Survey Test— "What if everyone followed my example?" (1 Timothy 4:12)
- 4. Spiritual Test—"Am I being people-pressured or Spirit-led?" (Galatians 1:10)
- 5. Stumbling Test— "Could this cause another person to stumble?" (Romans 14:21)
- Serenity Test— "Have I prayed and received peace about this decision?" (Philippians 4:6–7)
- 7. Sanctification Test—"Will this keep me from growing in the character of Christ?"
 (2 Corinthians 3:18)
- 8. Supreme Test—"Does this glorify God?" (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Chosen Romans 9:11,15,21

The July newsletter article closed with the following words: "Since we are incapable of orchestrating and executing our salvation, how can we be saved from sin? Stay tuned to the next newsletter in October or get with me so we can discuss."

The Bible is clear on the matter of God's sovereignty. He is sovereign. Man is not sovereign. What does that statement mean, "man is not sovereign"? It means that regarding the order of salvation, we cannot say man picks God; then God saves. Instead, God selects us.


God does not choose us based on our goodness or our <u>potential</u> goodness. Certain theological beliefs teach in the Christian world that God predestines us because he looks forward into the future and sees that we will call on Him. That is how they justify the chosen or predestined theology within the Bible. Unfortunately, that is not correct. The Bible is clear in Ephesians 1:4-8, that God chose us "before the foundation of the world", "according to His will." Why would He do this? As we described last time, we are consumed by sin and cannot turn from it, apart from His drawing us to Himself. He chooses us and thus "all the praise and glory of His grace" is on display. His choice has nothing to do with our merits. It has everything to do with His grace.




