Devotion: Judge, Mediator or Both?

1 Samuel 2: 22 - 25

What is Easter About? - Part 2

Do you understand what Easter means for us? If so, you are fortunate to comprehend the miracle of this event. When I use the word miracle, I am not talking about Jesus overcoming the tomb. So, what would I consider a miracle if the Resurrection of Jesus is not **the** miracle? Easter is the celebration of the Resurrection. We can only genuinely celebrate **if** we have been born again. To be born again is the most powerful miracle of all. It demonstrates God in His most merciful expression.

Peter's first letter shows that something dramatic, something supernatural, had happened inside of him; and Peter communicates the origin of this change in the greeting of his first epistle. Peter wrote in his first letter what the Resurrection means to him in 1 Peter 1:3. Please open your Bible to 1 Peter 1:3 and read. It is the central basis of hope. He, along with other believers, has hope that can come only from the Resurrection. How does Peter or any of us have hope amid trials?

Here's a summary of the events of the Resurrection: Finding the stone rolled away, the women entered the tomb. While they were still in the tomb, the angel appeared (Mark 16:4-5). The angel who spoke reminded them of Jesus' promises, then sent them to find Peter and the disciples to report that Jesus was risen (Matt. 28:7-8; Mark 16:6-7; Luke 24:6-8). The women did as they were told (Luke 24:9 - 10). The disciples were skeptical at first (Luke 24:11), but ran to the tomb, John arriving first (John 20:4), but Peter entered the tomb first (John 20:6). They saw the linen wrappings intact but empty, proof that Jesus had risen (Luke 24:12; John 20:6 -8). They left immediately (Luke 24:12; John 20:10). Because of this, we have hope. Because of these events, we can experience the miracle. 1 Peter 1:3 reminds us that the Resurrection is not part of the Christian faith; it is the Christian faith. Why should we not live with certainty for Jesus?

All ladies are welcome to attend. Please sign up at the Welcome Center. Details will be provided on the sign up sheet.


