





And He Dwelt Among Us

Various religions ascribe the word deity regarding the one they worship. Those religious beliefs would not subscribe to the notion that their gods sink so low as to take on the form of man and dwell with his worshippers. However, Christianity is based on this very belief. In John 1:14, the Bible says, "And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth. NASB" Christianity is rooted in the belief that the God of the Holy Bible is the One and Only True God. Therefore, He is God whether we worship Him or not.

He is the Creator of all things. In the early verses of John, the Word is described as the Creator. If we read the Bible and believe it, we realize that the God of the Bible created us, sustains us, provided a way for us to be reconciled to Him, and has created a way for us to spend eternity with Him.

Let us look back at John 1:14. It tells us that the Word became flesh. Throughout time, many religions would say that their deity appeared in human form from time to time. John is not saying that Jesus "appeared to be human." More than likely, John is responding to the first century critics' claim that Jesus only "appeared" to be human. Those people would say that Jesus "appeared" to die on the cross. John is emphatic as he writes that Jesus, The Word, became flesh. He continues in that verse to say, "He dwelt among us." The Gospel John wrote focuses on God dwelling among us.

Why is it so important for us to get this right? Eternal salvation is based on a Savior, who is God, who became flesh because we could not earn salvation. The Word became flesh to provide the payment for our sin. We owe everything to Jesus. I encourage you to use this verse to help solidify your understanding of the entirety of Scripture.

Let us pray we honor Him during 2025.




