



### People of God: Part 2

What behavior should accompany those who profess to be God's people? The purported answers puzzle the world. These varied behaviors can be confusing.

We must begin with the premise that the people of God are filled with the Holy Spirit. John 14:16-17 describes the Holy Spirit's presence within the believer. The Holy Spirit does not dwell within those who habitually exhibit worldly behavior. Romans 8:9 explicitly states that if the Holy Spirit is not leading or guiding you from within, you are not a part of the people of God.

The Fruit of the Spirit is described in Galatians 5:22-23. The first fruit is "love". Every person of God will possess love for others. They will have compassion for those lost in sin and a deep desire to see them saved. They will love their fellow Christians. This love will be genuine. It will originate from the Holy Spirit that is inside us. The Holy Spirit transforms over time those who were once lost into people of holiness. This is known as sanctification. Justification describes how we are reconciled to God, and it serves as the essential underpinning to the Fruits of the Spirit.

While love may be first in the listing, it is by no means something that is fully realized quickly. Our fleshly desire can make it difficult to fully experience the beauty of loving those around us. Jesus told us to "love one another". He issued that as a command in John 13:34, "I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another; just as I have loved you, that you also love one another." We will look more closely at the traits of love and then continue the Fruits of the Spirit.
