Music Notes

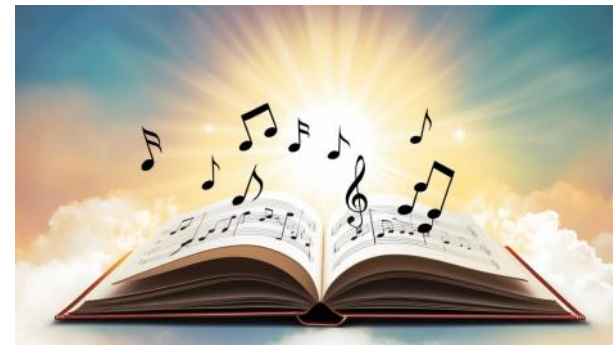

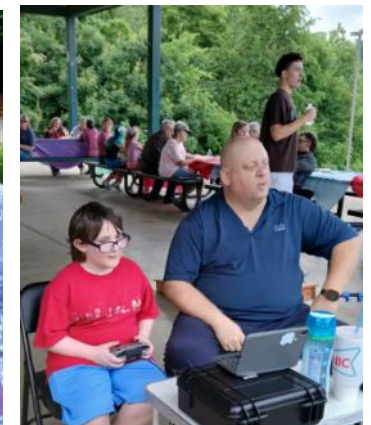

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People of God : Part 6

Galatians 5:22-23: ²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Last quarter, we emphasized the Spirit-filled trait of peace. In Galatians 5:22-23, Paul speaks of the fruits of the Spirit. He lists love, joy, peace, **patience**, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. The focus for this quarter will be on patience.

Patience is one thing people always want others to have with them and fail to extend to others. It is a trait that is highly coveted in a friend or colleague and certainly in a spouse. Generally, patience comes with maturity. But the kind of patience Paul is writing about can only come from the Spirit that dwells within a believer.

If we look at the Bible, we discover many examples of patience. Jesus demonstrated incredible patience when He hung on the cross and asked the Father to forgive those mistreating Him. A human in their own capacity would have hurled accusations at the accusers.

Our world is full of challenges. Within these challenges, we must demonstrate patience. When examining the Fruit of the Spirit, one can see that patience is at the heart of the other fruits. To exhibit "agape" love, we must possess patience. To exhibit infectious joy, we must display patience. To exhibit peace in circumstances beyond our control, we must possess patience. Examples of this are:

You cannot sustain **love** without patience, because people will inevitably disappoint you.

You cannot maintain **peace** or **joy** without patience, because a chaotic world will constantly threaten to disrupt them.

You cannot express true **kindness** or **goodness** to a difficult person unless patience paves the way first.

Biblical patience isn't a passive, weak resignation where you let people walk all over you. It is a robust, quiet strength. It is the power to suffer wrong for a long time without retaliating, even when you have the power to do so.

I pray that whatever you are experiencing right now, God will grant you the patience to endure to the end. Please remember - God loves you, and I am praying for you.

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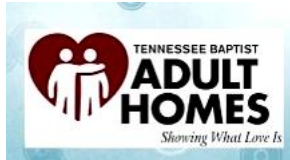

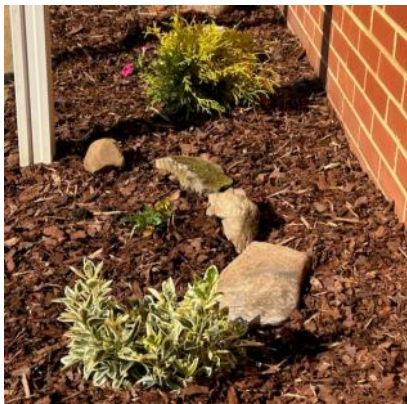
